New for this year, we have constructed a couple of wheelchair accessible shooting venues, so we are very excited about the opportunity to host these young men. The goal is, of course, for these soldiers to have a great hunting experience without any expense to them, while creating awareness for the WWIA organization and the fine things they do.
