Calcutta Rules & Ties

Each boat entered into the tournament will be **eligible** to participate in the "Calcutta" Auction. The purchase price will begin at \$200.00 for Offshore Division and \$100.00 for Inshore Division. The Calcutta purse will be split among the top 3 qualified contenders in each division in a 50-30-20 split.

Ties— In case of a tie, the captains will be offered the opportunity to split the purse. If they choose not to split the purse then a drawing will be held from the division's fish categories and the largest fish caught from the category drawn will determine how the boats place in the tournament.

Please note that even though all boats entered into the tournament are eligible to participate in the Calcuttas, only the boats which participate in the Calcutta Auction will be eligible to win the Calcutta purse.

Kip Wise Offshore Award - Jim Boothe Inshore Award

The **Kip Wise Offshore Award** will be given to the Captain of the boat fishing in the Offshore Division with the largest point total.

The **Jim Boothe Inshore Award** will be given to the Captain of the boat in the Inshore Division with the largest point total.

All boats must declare a division prior to the tournament. Points will be awarded on the following basis for each species of fish: **1st Place—10 points; 2nd Place—7 points 3rd Place—5 points.**

Please note that it is not mandatory for boats entered into the tournament to participate in the Calcutta, making it possible for a boat that has not participated in the Calcutta, to win the Kip Wise or Jim Boothe Award and not receive the Calcutta purse.

Tournament Rules

The Tournament will be eighteen (18)

holes over the **Gulf Shores Country Club**. A SCRAMBLE FORMAT will be utilized. Club Pro Rae Schuesler will serve as official Scorer and Judge.

All teams will be flighted into three flights based upon team's combined handicaps and ties will be broken by scorecard playoff beginning with the #1 handicap hole.

Tees used will depend on team's score from the previous hole:

-blue tees following all birdies or better

-gold tees following all pars

-white tees following all bogeys or worse

All Teams

will begin from Gold Tees

Out of bounds defined by white stakes,

boundary fences, and residential roads.

All lakes, culverts, and ditches shall be played as water hazards.

All USGA rules will be in effect along with the following local rules:

1. Repair all ball marks.
2. Lies may be improved anywhere except water hazards by one (1) club length. Lies may be improved 6" on the green. Putts "within the leather" are good, plus one stroke.
3. Putts within the leather are good, plus one stroke.
4. Exceptionally slow groups should let faster groups play through, but only if there is an open hole ahead.
5. Each player must see that his score card is turned into the Golf Pro at the Golf Shop, in order to be eligible for a prize
6. Any and all decisions of the Golf Committee will be final. Prizes will be awarded to the winning Net teams in each flight (the number of winning teams will be determined by

the Committee). The Overall Lowest ScoringNet team will be the ultimate winners of the tournament and their names will be placed on the permanent plaque in The Construction Center. Prizes will also be awarded to the lowest Gross Team.

The Shotgun start will take place at **8:30 A.M. SHARP!** The Committee asks that everyone make an effort to be at the course no later than **8:00 A.M.** Anyone, who is late will join his group and finish the round. Following the round, and time permitting, the holes which were missed may be made up. In order to be eligible for a golf prize, a team must complete all 18 holes.

The Tournament Committee wishes to remind everyone that we are the guests of the Gulf Shores Country Club. As guests, we should endeavor to conduct ourselves as gentlemen and show the utmost respect for the Course and the club's equipment and facilities.

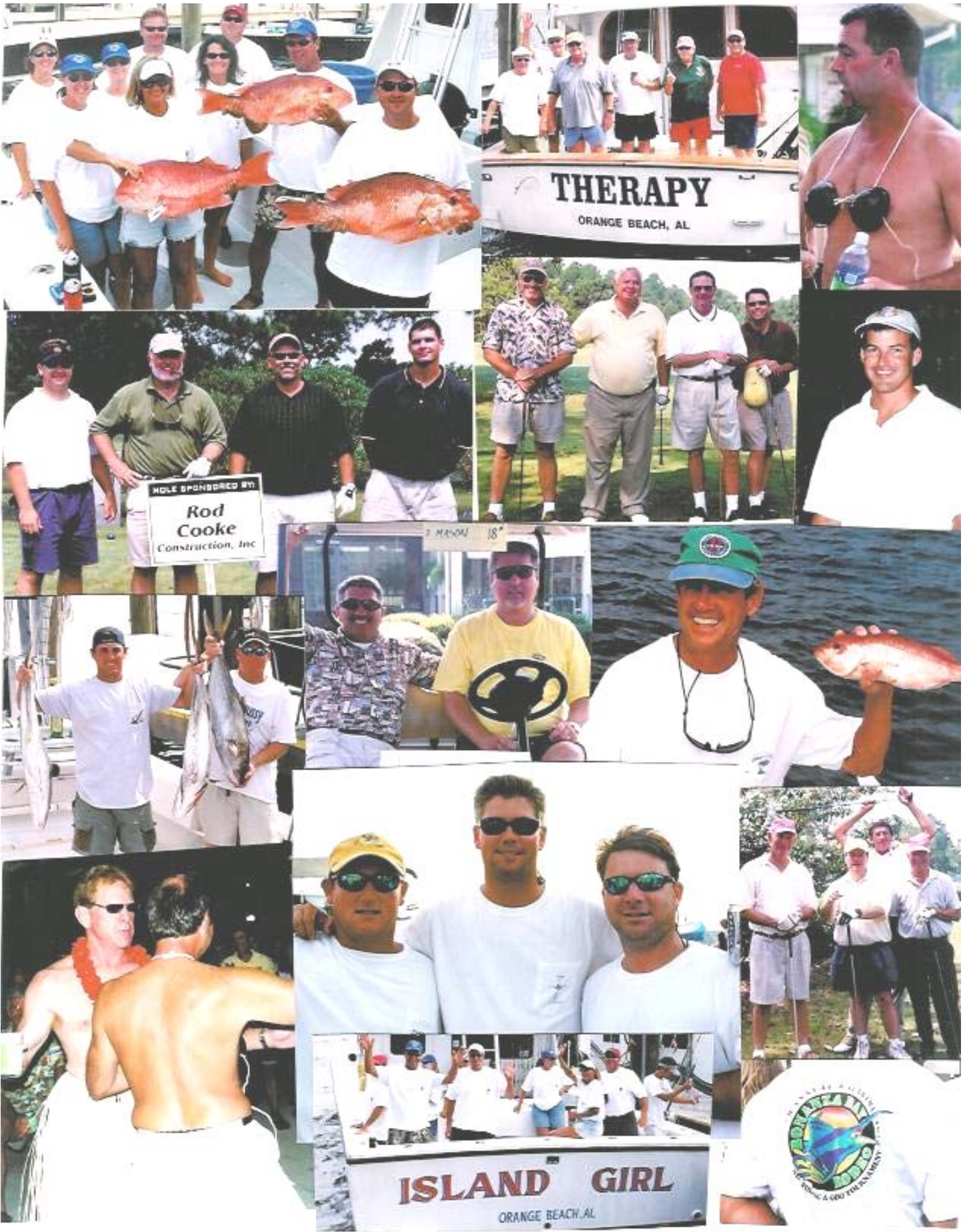

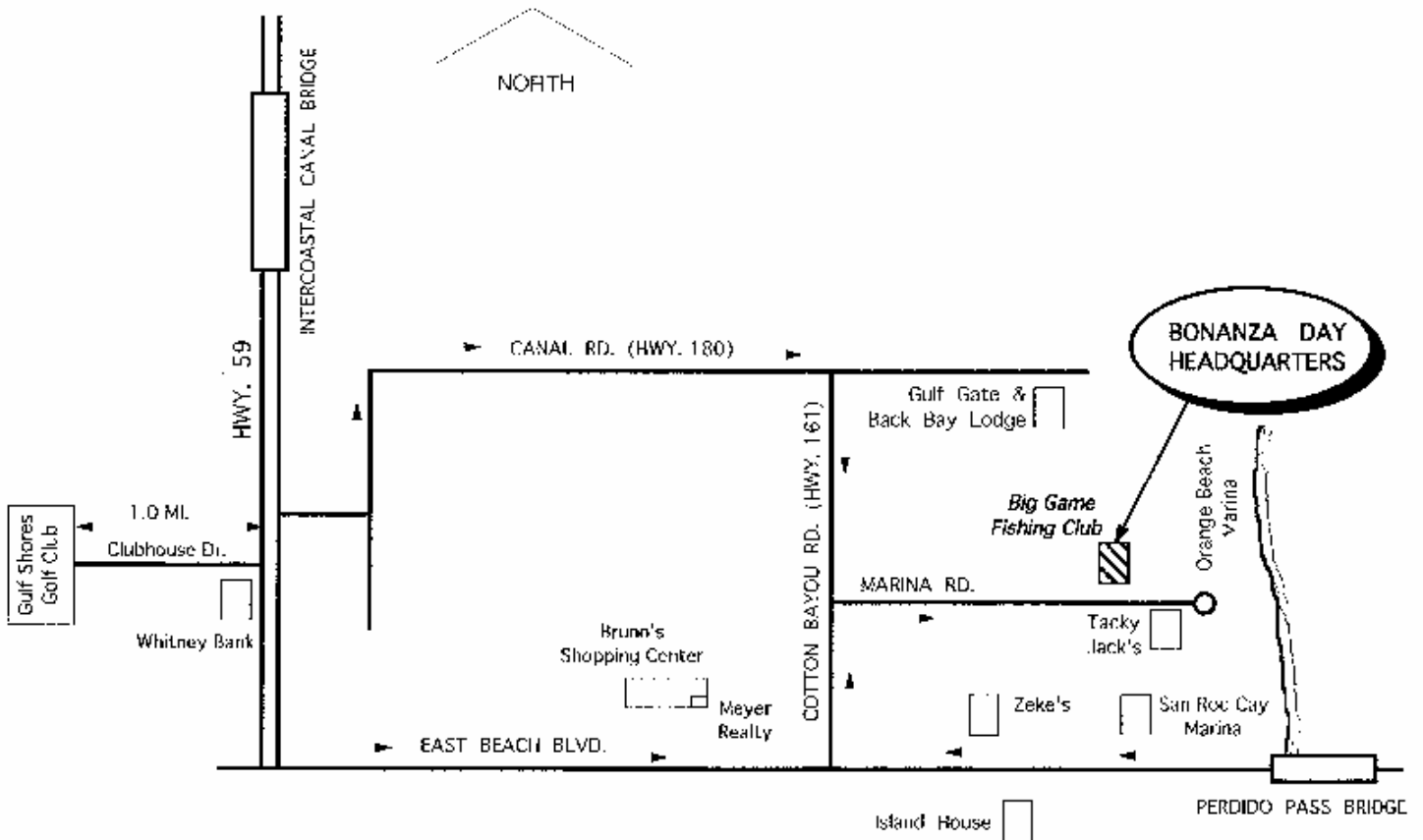
